NOTICE OF QUESTION

I give notice that on **Thursday, 22nd of September 2016** I shall ask the **Honorable Minister of Urban and Rural Development, Sophia Shaningwa**, the following questions regarding National Housing Enterprise (NHE) Board. The National Housing Enterprise Board has appointed one of its directors as Acting Chief Executive Officer (CEO) contrary to Section 10 (4) of the National Housing Enterprise Act, Act No.: 5 of 1995, as amended. As a result of contravening the Act, NHE was taken to court and inevitably lost the case. Furthermore, the respondents in this court case were ordered by the court to pay the applicant costs jointly and severally.

- 1) Honorable Minister, what was your involvement in the appointment of a Board Member as an Acting CEO of NHE?
- 2) Is it true, as widely reported in the media, that you Honorable Minister have been advised by the Attorney General to appoint NHE Board member as Acting CEO?
- 3) In case the appointment was made without your knowledge, what steps did you take to bring the culprits to book for this gross negligence?
- 4) In your honest opinion, do you think that it is proper for the public out there to foot bills of this nature, where people responsible for the implementation of the law are negligent in their duties?
